EXCESS MANUFACTURING CAPACITY A CONCERN

US, China to talk on balanced economic growth, says Yellen

Both nations to work on anti-money laundering efforts

Guangzhou, April 6

US TREASURY SECRETARY Janet Yellen said on Saturday that she and Chinese Vice-Premier He Lifeng agreed to launch exchanges on balanced economic growth, an effort partly aimed at addressing US concerns about China's excess manufacturing capacity.

After two days of economic talks in China's southern export hub of Guangzhou, Yellen said she and He also agreed to start a forum to cooperate on anti-money laundering efforts in their respective financial systems. The exchanges "will facilitate a discussion around macro-economic imbalances, including their connection to over-capacity, and I intend to use the opportunity to advocate

for a level playing field for American workers and firms," Yellen said in a statement released at the conclusion of the talks.

She characterised the discussions as productive and frank. Coming into her four-

day visit to China, her top priority was to persuade Chinese officials to rein in excess production capacity for electric vehicles (EVs), solar panels and other clean energy technology that threaten competing firms in the US and other countries.

Chinese state media pushed back on her excess capacity arguments, calling them a "pretext" for protectionist US policies. Such comments seek to undermine China's domestic growth and international cooperation, and Washington

should focus on fostering innovation and competitiveness within its own borders instead of resorting to "fear-mongering," state news agency Xinhua said in an editorial. Yellen, He and their teams held over four and a half hours of meetings on Saturday on a range of topics, with US concerns about China's growing exports of electric vehicles, solar panels and other goods the biggest priority for the Treasury chief. They discussed the excess capacity issue for over two hours, Yellen told reporters. "I think the Chinese realise how concerned we are about the implications of their industrial strategy, for the United States, for the potential to flood our markets with exports that make it difficult for American firms to compete," Yellen said. "And then other countries have the same concern." She said the forum would provide a "structured" way to discuss a complicated issue but that it would take some time to resolve.

17 Indians lured into unsafe, illegal work in Laos on way back home: EAM Jaishankar

SEVENTEEN INDIAN WORKERS, who were lured into unsafe and illegal work in Laos, are on their way back home, external affairs minister S Jaishankar said on Saturday. He also complimented the Indian embassy in Laos for its successful efforts in the case.

In a post on X, he said, "Modi ki Guarantee works for all at home and abroad. Seventeen Indian workers, lured into unsafe and illegal work in Laos, are on their way back home." "Well done, @IndianEmbaos. Thank Lao authorities for their support for the safe repatriation," he added.

The external affairs ministry on Thursday cautioned Indian nationals against falling prey to human traffickers promising lucrative job opportunities in Cambodia. In an advisory, the ministry called upon Indians looking at job opportunities in the southeast Asian country to thoroughly check the background of the prospective employer. "It has

come to attention that Indian nationals, lured by fake promises of lucrative job opportunities in Cambodia, are falling into the trap of human traffickers," it said. The ministry said these Indian nationals are "coerced" to undertake online financial scams and

other illegal activities. "Indian nationals intending to visit Cambodia for employment are cautioned to do so only through authorised agents. It is also advised that the background of the prospective employer in Cambodia is checked thoroughly," it said.

CITIES AND TOWNS ACROSS a swath of upstate New York will have a rare moment in the spotlight on Monday — once they're shrouded in complete darkness.

For the first time in almost a century, the western and northern parts of New York state will experience a total eclipse. The path of totality — a narrow stretch where the Moon obscures the Sun entirely — tracks across cities and towns including Buffalo, Rochester, Syracuse and Jamestown. Though the entire event will last for several hours, the main spectacle — when day turns to night — is expected to last only about four minutes. And yet the buildup has been years in the making. "This is like our Super Bowl or Taylor Swift concert," said Patrick Kaler, chief executive officer of tourism agency Visit Buffalo Niagara. The first tour group booked an excursion to the area for the event on the heels of a partial

More than half of US cities along the eclipse's path are fully booked for the night of April 7, according to data from AirDNA, a data analytics company, with thousands of Airbnb listings in the path of totality slated to reach 100% occupancy. In the Adirondacks and North Country, troopers are telling commuters to brace for traffic jams as long as 12 hours, and other areas are also expecting heavy congestion. "I'll be biking to work," said Tommy Cowan, managing partner of Patrick's Rooftop, a Buffalo bar. Resurgence Brewing, the Buffalo-based brewing company released an eclipse-themed draft beer — time-stamped 3.18 pm, the moment Buffalo will experience totality — that sold out twice as fast as the average seasonal beer. The company is also hosting an "eclipse bash" that's expected to turn out thousands, according to Jeff Ware, president of the brewery. Among the guests will be Andy Parker, a local weatherman who will lead discussions about the eclipse.

Following are some selected events for viewing the eclipse:

NASA at Niagara Falls: The US space agency will be taking over Niagara Falls State Park. It will offer a range of stellar-related activities, including programming led by astronauts and scientists, space-themed performances as well as planetarium shows.

Lake Erie Wine Country: A group of 21 wineries on the shoreline of the Great Lake, is hosting a four-day food and wine tasting that will culminate in a ticket-holders-only event to view the spectacle.

Syracuse Mets: Baseball fans can stargaze at something other than their favourite players at the first-ever eclipse of the Park at NBT Bank Stadium in Syracuse. The first 10,000 people through the gate — set to open at 2 p.m. — will receive complimentary eclipse glasses.

Vintage train: The A&A Railroad in Rochester offers a train ride as magical as being aboard the Polar Express.

solar eclipse in 2017, he said. While the tourism boom will be brief, it's a welcome economic jolt for the region, which has been hard-hit by the loss of its industrial base. The manufacturing sector in New York shrank by more than 60% between the 1940s and 2009, according to a

Pak slams Rajnath Singh's provocative remarks, says it will safeguard sovereignty

PAKISTAN SAID IT stands resolute in its intent and ability to safeguard its sovereignty, a day after Defence Minister Rajnath Singh made it clear that India will enter Pakistan if terrorists run away to the neighbouring nation after carrying out terror strikes in the country.

A statement by the Foreign Office said that Pakistan has always demonstrated its commitment to peace in the region but its desire for peace should not be misconstrued. "History attests to Pakistan's firm resolve and ability to protect and defend itself," the Foreign Office said in

a statement while criticising India's ruling dispensation for resorting to hateful rhetoric for electoral gains. The statement came in response to Singh's statement that if terrorists try to disturb peace in India or carry out terror activities, a befitting response will be given and if terrorists run away to Pakistan, India will enter the neighbouring country to kill them. Singh was responding to a question on a report by *The Guardian*, that claimed Indian agencies carried out assassinations of terrorists as part of an approach to national security after 2019. —PTI

Though the entire event will last for several hours, the main spectacle — when day turns to night — is expected to last only about four minutes. And yet the buildup has been years in the making. "This is like our Super Bowl or Taylor Swift concert," said Patrick Kaler, chief executive officer of tourism agency Visit Buffalo Niagara. The first tour group booked an excursion to the area for the event on the heels of a partial

total eclipse in 2017, he said. While the tourism boom will be brief, it's a welcome economic jolt for the region, which has been hard-hit by the loss of its industrial base. The manufacturing sector in New York shrank by more than 60% between the 1940s and 2009, according to a

US, China to talk on balanced economic growth, says Yellen

Both nations to work on anti-money laundering efforts

US TREASURY SECRETARY Janet Yellen said on Saturday that she and Chinese Vice-Premier He Lifeng agreed to launch exchanges on balanced economic growth, an effort partly aimed at addressing US concerns about China's excess manufacturing capacity.

After two days of economic talks in China's southern export hub of Guangzhou, Yellen said she and He also agreed to start a forum to cooperate on anti-money laundering efforts in their respective financial systems. The exchanges "will facilitate a discussion around macro-economic imbalances, including their connection to overcapacity, and I intend to use the opportunity to advocate

for a level playing field for American workers and firms," Yellen said in a statement released at the conclusion of the talks.

She characterised the discussions as productive and frank. Coming into her four-

day visit to China, her top priority was to persuade Chinese officials to rein in excess production capacity for electric vehicles (EVs), solar panels and other clean energy technology that threaten competing firms in the US and other countries.

Chinese state media pushed back on her excess capacity arguments, calling them a "pretext" for protectionist US policies. Such comments seek to undermine China's domestic growth and international cooperation, and Washington

should focus on fostering innovation and competitiveness within its own borders instead of resorting to "fear-mongering," state news agency Xinhua said in an editorial. Yellen, He and their teams held over four and a half hours of meetings on Saturday on a range of topics, with US concerns about China's growing exports of electric vehicles, solar panels and other goods the biggest priority for the Treasury chief. They discussed the excess capacity issue for over two hours, Yellen told reporters. "I think the Chinese realise how concerned we are about the implications of their industrial strategy, for the United States, for the potential to flood our markets with exports that make it difficult for American firms to compete," Yellen said. "And then other countries have the same concern." She said the forum would provide a "structured" way to discuss a complicated issue but that it would take some time to resolve.

CITIES AND TOWNS ACROSS a swath of upstate New York will have a rare moment in the spotlight on Monday — once they're shrouded in complete darkness.

For the first time in almost a century, the western and northern parts of New York state will experience a total eclipse. The path of totality — a narrow stretch where the Moon obscures the Sun entirely — tracks across cities and towns including Buffalo, Rochester, Syracuse and Jamestown. Though the entire event will last for several hours, the main spectacle — when day turns to night — is expected to last only about four minutes. And yet the buildup has been years in the making. "This is like our Super Bowl or Taylor Swift concert," said Patrick Kaler, chief executive officer of tourism agency Visit Buffalo Niagara. The first tour booked an excursion to the area for the event on the heels of a partial

solar eclipse in 2017, he said.

While the tourism boom will be brief, it's a welcome economic jolt for the region, which has been hard-hit by the loss of its industrial base. The manufacturing sector in New York shrank by more than 60% between the 1940s and 2009, according to a

report by the state comptroller. Buffalo will be one of the biggest beneficiaries. The state's second-biggest city is anticipating as many as a million visitors, according to Common Council Member Joel P. Ferolito. That's the same as the entire population of Erie County.

More than half of US cities along the eclipse's path are fully booked for the night of April 7, according to data from AirDNA, a data analytics company, with thousands of Airbnb listings in the path of totality slated to reach 100% occupancy. In the Adirondacks and North Country, troopers are telling commuters to brace for traffic jams as long as 12 hours, and other areas are also expecting heavy congestion. "I'll be biking to work," said Tommy Cowan, managing partner of Patrick's Rooftop, a Buffalo bar. Resurgence Brewing, the Buffalo-based brewing company released an eclipse-themed draft beer — time-stamped 3.18 pm, the moment Buffalo will experience totality — that sold out twice as fast as the average seasonal beer. The company is also hosting an "eclipse bash" that's expected to turn out thousands, according to Jeff Ware, president of the brewery. Among the guests will be Andy Parker, a local weatherman who will lead discussions about the eclipse.

NASA at Niagara Falls: The US space agency will be taking over Niagara Falls State Park. It will offer a range of stellar-related activities, including programming led by astronauts and scientists, space-themed music performances as well as planetarium shows.

Lake Erie Wine Country: A group of 21 wineries on the shoreline of the Great Lake, is hosting a four-day food and wine tasting that will culminate in a ticket-holders-only event to view the spectacle.

Syracuse Mets: Baseball fans can stargaze at something other than their favourite players at the first-ever eclipse of the Park at NBT Bank Stadium in Syracuse. The first 10,000 people through the gate — set to open at 2 p.m. — will receive complimentary eclipse glasses.
